(FST) SCHOLARSHIP FUND PROGRAM

The Program:

The University of Belize FST Scholarship Fund is a collaboration between University of Belize's Student Clubs such as the Beautification, Chemistry, Environmental, Mathematics, and Information Technology Club with partnership from the UB Belmopan Student Government. It aims to provide multiple scholarship of the amount of five hundred dollars each to needed Faculty of Science & Technology (FST) students and students who are members of the participating clubs. FST students pay one of the highest tuition and fees at UB due to lab cost, overloads, field trips and other factors. In addition, with the recent tuition increase and global pandemic this scholarship fund aims to help needed FST and participating clubs' members to meet the mandatory financial obligations to attend the University of Belize.

The requirements to receive this scholarship will be based on the three pillars of the FST Scholarship Fund which are financial need, extracurricular activities and academics. University of Belize Associates & Bachelors students along with incoming Fourth form students are eligible to apply. Students must have at least a 3.0 C.G.PA, be active in their respective schools or/and community, and show financial need to be eligible for the UB FST Scholarship Fund. Eligible recipients must come from the Faculty of Science & Technology or another other faculty given they are an active member in one of the participating clubs. The scholarship will be used for Fall 2020-1 semester; thus eligible participants must have at least one (1) semester remaining at the University of Belize starting August 2020.

Requirements

- 1.) The requirements to receive this scholarship will be based on the three pillars of the FST Scholarship Fund which are financial need, extracurricular activities and academics.
- 2.) Eligible applicants must fall under ONE or more of the following categories:
 - + Current Students of the Faculty of Science & Technology (FST)
 - + Incoming fourth-form students entering an FST program in Fall (August) semester.
 - + Active members of participating clubs
 - > Environmental Club
 - > Beautification Club
 - > Chemistry Club
 - > UBIT (Information Technology) Club
 - > Mathematics & Physics Club
- 3.) Students must have at least a 3.0 C.G.P.A, and be active in their respective schools or/and community
- 4.) Students must show financial need.
- 5.) The scholarship will be used for Fall 2020-1 semester; thus eligible participants must have at least one (1) semester remaining at the University of Belize starting August 2020.

Deadline: 17 July 2020

Application Checklist

- 1.) E-Copy of letter of acceptance from the University of Belize. (Not needed if applicant is already enrolled at UB)
- 2.) E-Copy of Transcript
 - +Accessed from student portal if applicant has already attended a semester a UB. Download current grade report and upload it in this online application form.
 - +Incoming fourth form students need to scan a copy of their transcript and upload in this online form.
- 3.) 300 Word Essay expressing financial need and leadership(** See "Essay Outline" section below for more details)
- 4.) 1 Reference Contact Information (Reference/Recommendation Letter NOT REQUIRED)
- 5.) Scan Copy of ID (Either Social Security Card, Passport or Birth Certificate)

Essay Outline

Submit a 300 word essay stating the reasons why you should be awarded funding. Be sure to include your history (personal and academic). Explain what leadership means to you and describe a situation in which your leadership made a difference. Describe what you accomplished. Also give a brief description on your financial situation.
